Evaluation/Assessment policy for Add on / Certificate Courses

Introduction:

College offers need based add on/ certificate courses of two credits (30 hours) approved by College Development Committee. The curriculum for these courses has been devised by the college faculty adhering to the local needs of students. Students can enrol to these courses in parallel to the major programmes they are studying. These add on/ certificate courses help students to acquaint with the professional skills. The evaluation process for these courses is carried out at departmental level. Departments in Arts, Commerce, Science, BCS and BBA (CA) are supposed to adopts varied evaluation strategies.

Policy Statement:

Policy Statement for Arts Faculty:

Add on/Certificate courses in arts faculty are framed as per the under graduate and post graduate programmes offered in the college. The course content is imparted to students through lectures, practicals, discussions. At places field visits and hands on training are arranged for exposing students' newer fields of knowledge. At the conclusion of 30 hour course, the performance of the participants is evaluated through a written examination. The question paper comprising of 25 multiple choice questions for 50 marks is prepared by the concerned faculty. The students who could score more than 40% of marks are awarded with course completion certificate.

Policy Statement for Commerce Faculty:

The commerce faculty offers a certificate course in Accounting in TALLY ERP-9 in collaboration with TALLY International Ltd. Bangalore. The final year students (T.Y.B.Com) are preferably enrolled to this course. The course is of 60 sessions including theory lectures and practical sessions. At the conclusion of the course, the assessment is done through an online examination conducted by Tally International, Bangalore. The students who scores minimum 40% marks in the examination are eligible to get course completion certificate.

Policy Statement for Science Faculty:

The add on/ certificate courses under science faculty are practical based. They are helpful in imbibing the practical and professional skills among the students. The curriculum of these courses is prepared by keeping in view the recent advances in the field of science and technology. The assessment of students enrolled to add on/ certificate courses is done through both a theory examination and active participation of students in practical. Students punctuality, individual performance in group activity are also considered for the assessment.

The question paper of 25 multiple choice question for 50 marks is prepared by the concerned faculty. The students who score minimum 40% marks are eligible to get a course completion certificate. The certificates are issued on the basis of regular attendance and score in written examination.

Policy Statement for BCS and BBA (CA):

The certificate courses offered in BCS and BBA (CA) departments have practical approach. They focus on enhancement of practical and professional skills. The course content is imparted through theory lectures and hands on training sessions. Assessment of students is done through written examination of 50 marks. Students who scores minimum 40% marks are eligible to get course completion certificate.

Policy Statement for Diploma Courses offered under Community College Scheme:

College offers diploma courses in Farm Equipment and Machinery, Aquaculture, Polyhouse Technolgy under Community College Scheme of UGC. The assessment of students enrolled for these courses is done as per the guidelines laid down by UGC. Particularly, Field Visits, Regular Attendance and Final Examination of 50 marks. Students who score minimum 40% marks are eligible to get course completion certificate.
