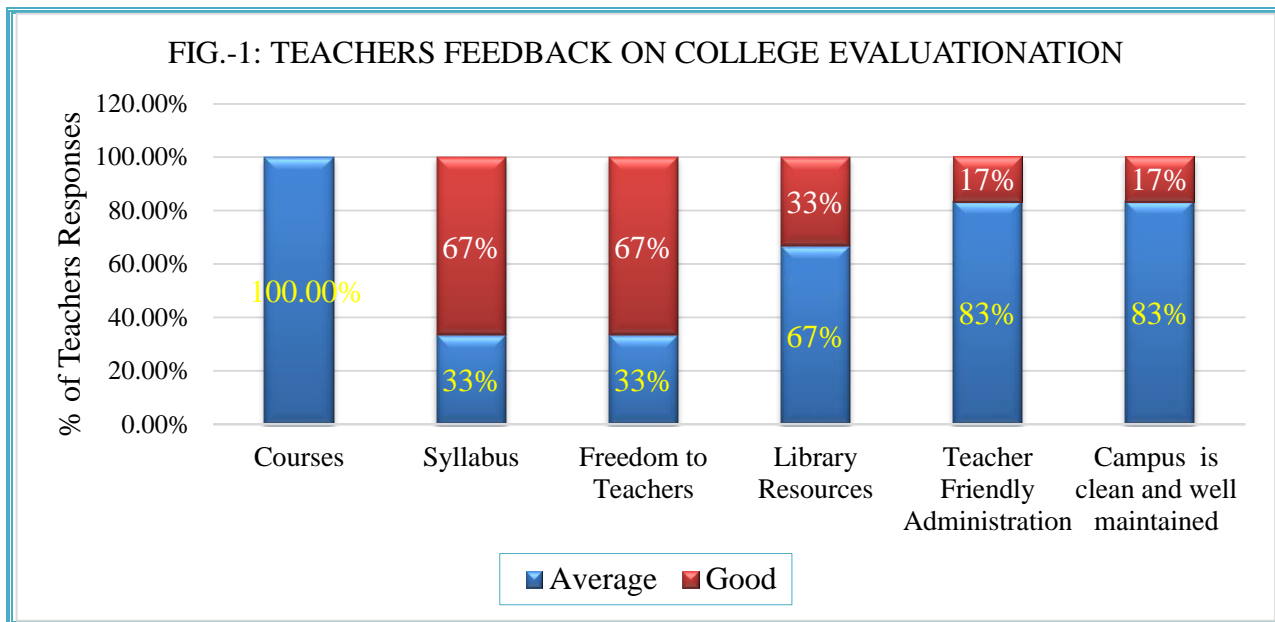
##### **3.1: Geography (BA/MA)**

6. Campus, Classrooms are clean and well maintained



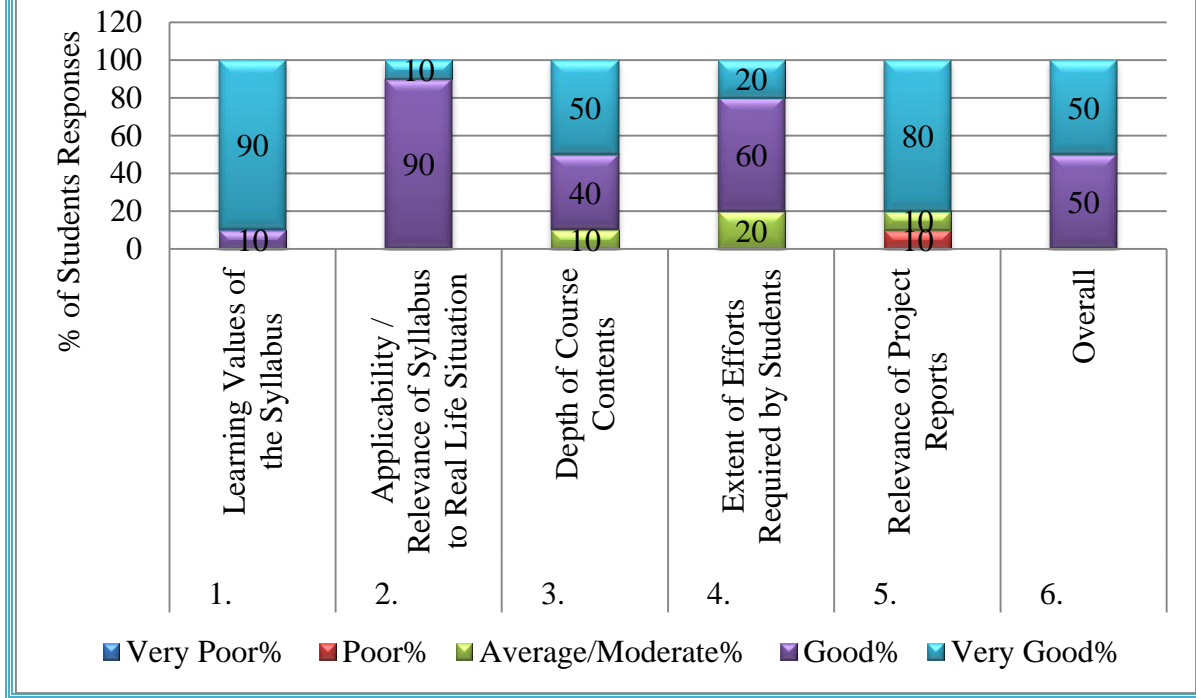

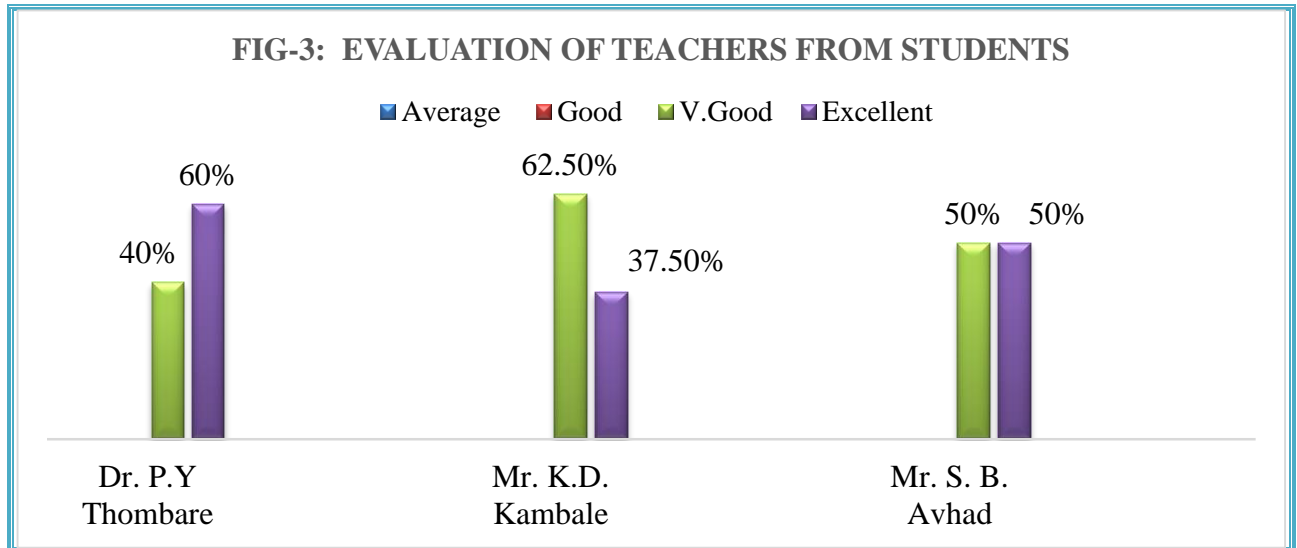
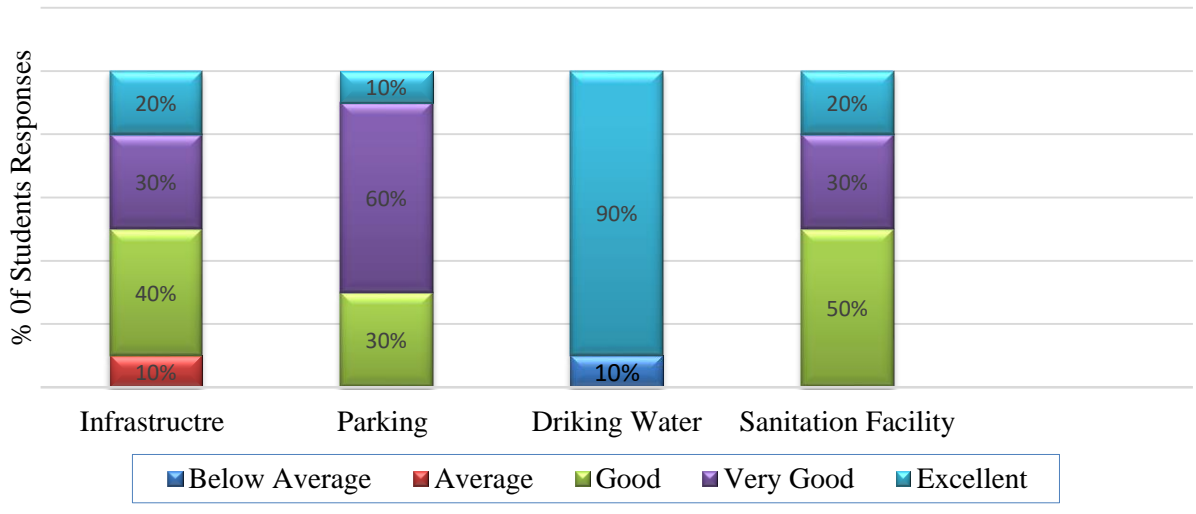


Table-3 and fig-3 clearly indicates that students of the Geography Department are happy with the performance of their teachers in terms of punctuality, subject knowledge, communication skills, use of modern teaching aids and positive approach. FIG.- 5: EVALUATION OF COLLEGE BY PARENTS

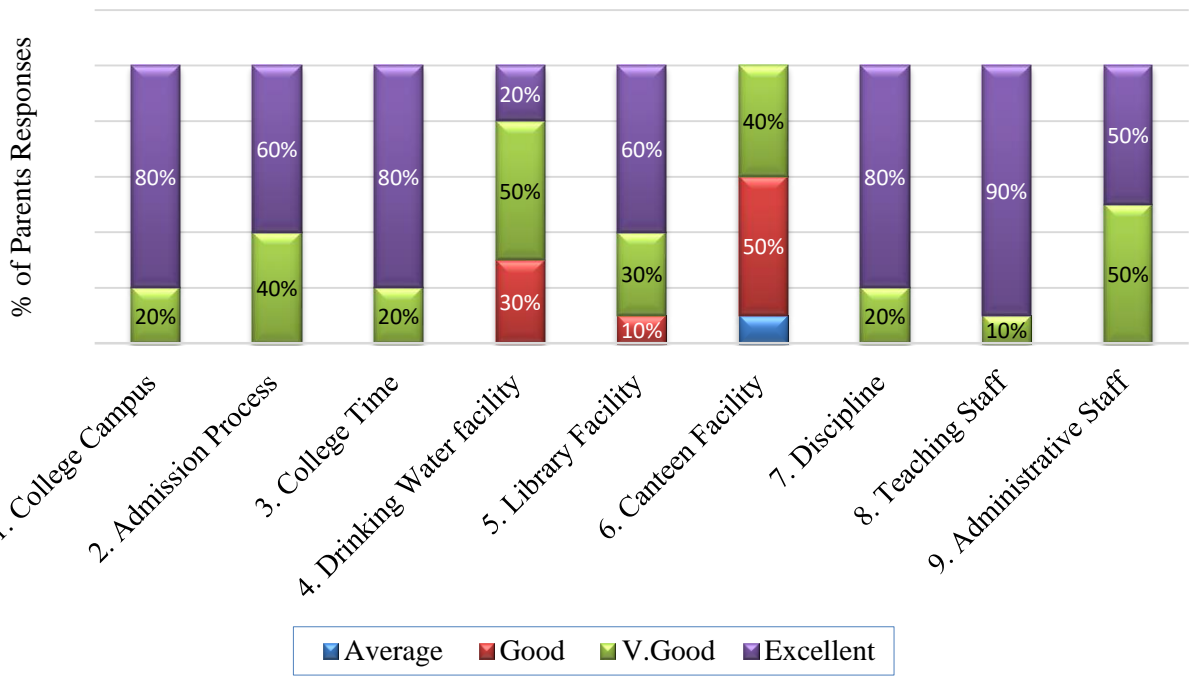
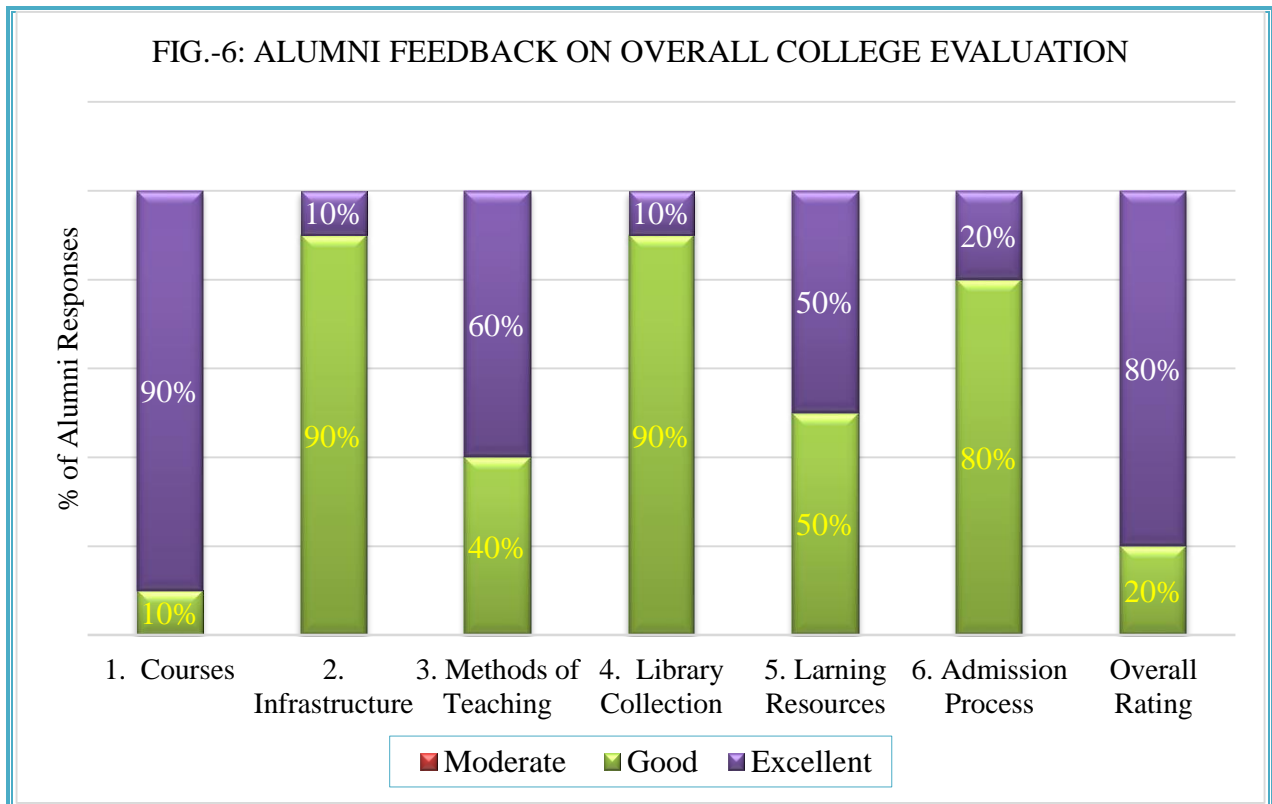




Fig.-5 shows that 20 to 80% parents' have scored excellent score over the nine aspects of college evaluation

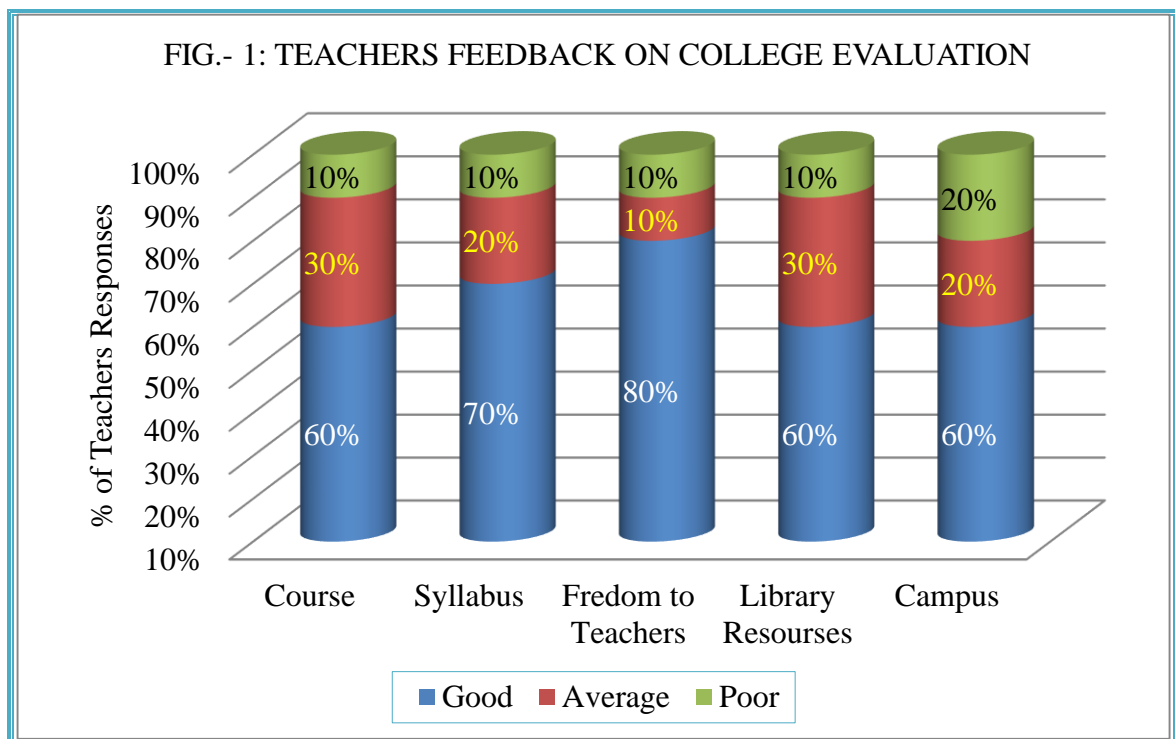


Fig.-1 illustrates that around 80% teachers have scored college in terms of above mentioned six aspects

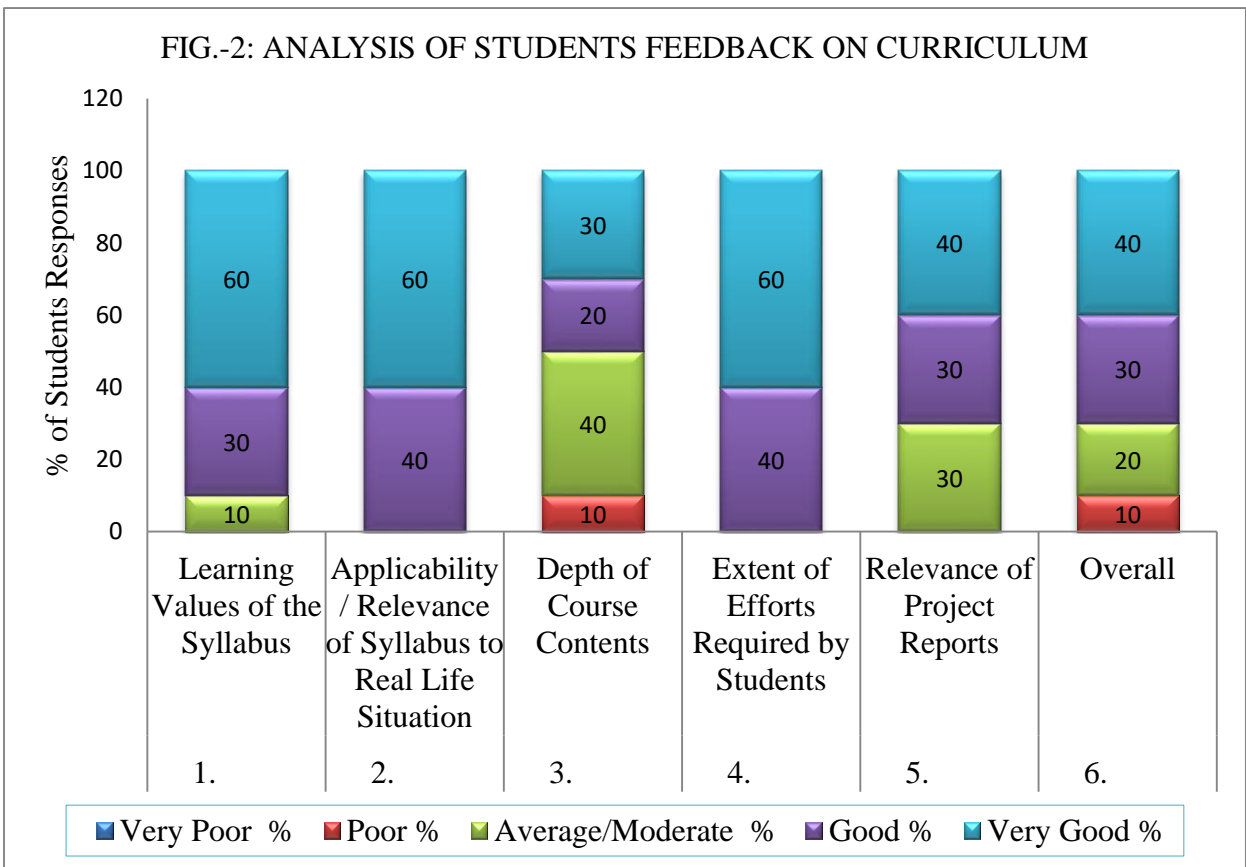

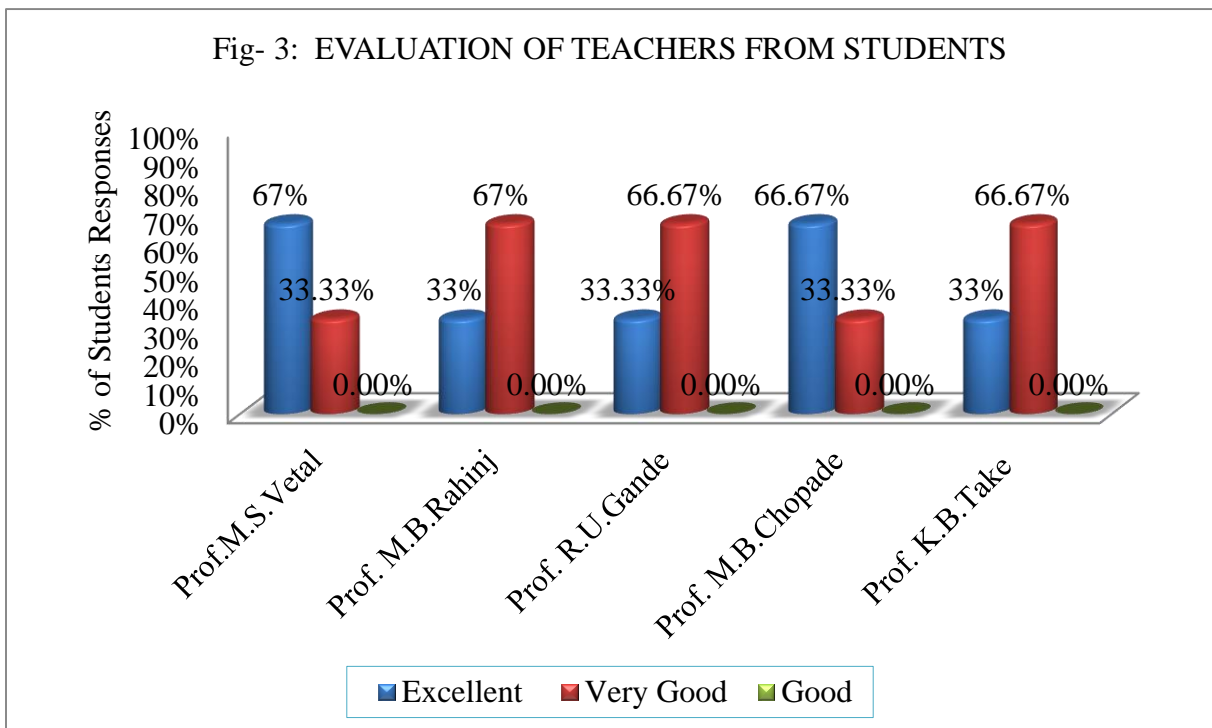


Fig-3 shows the teacher wise score given by students. About 67 percent students have scored their teachers as very good whereas 33% students have scored them excellent.

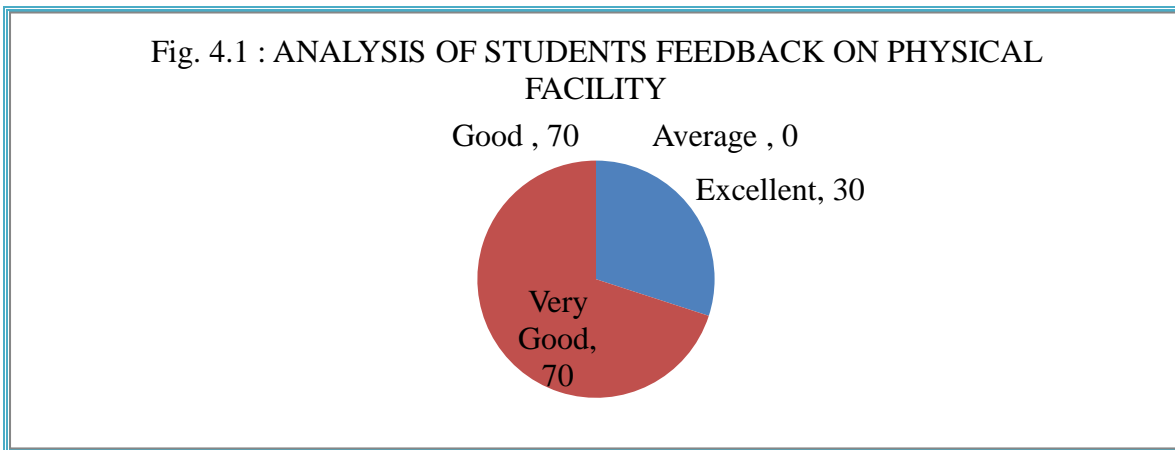
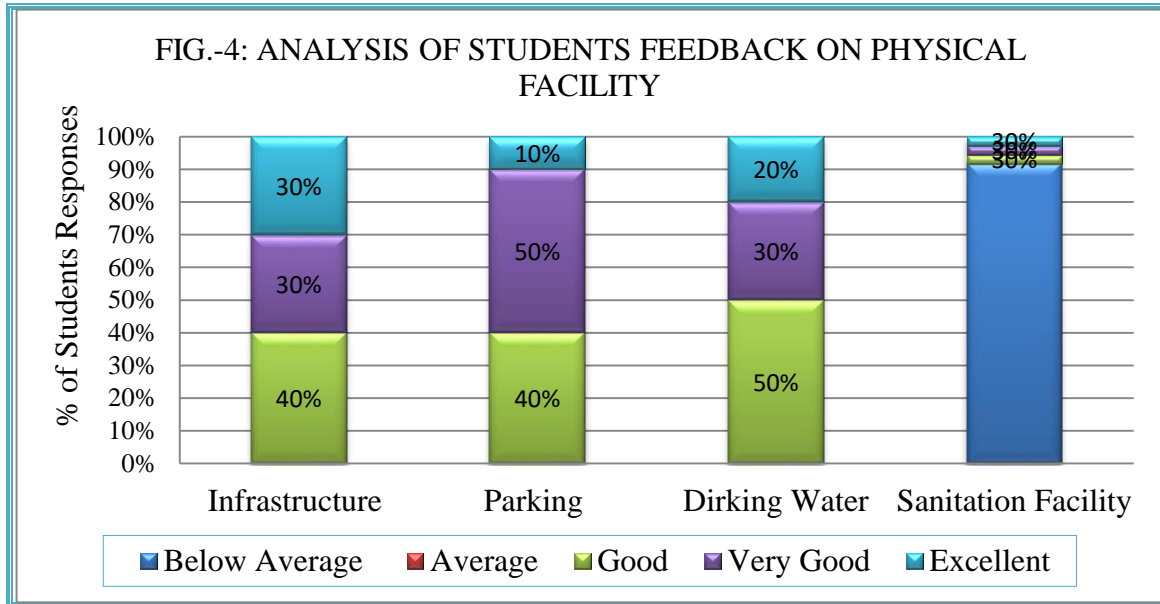


Figure-4 states that about 20 to 30% students have assigned excellent score to the physical facilities of the college.

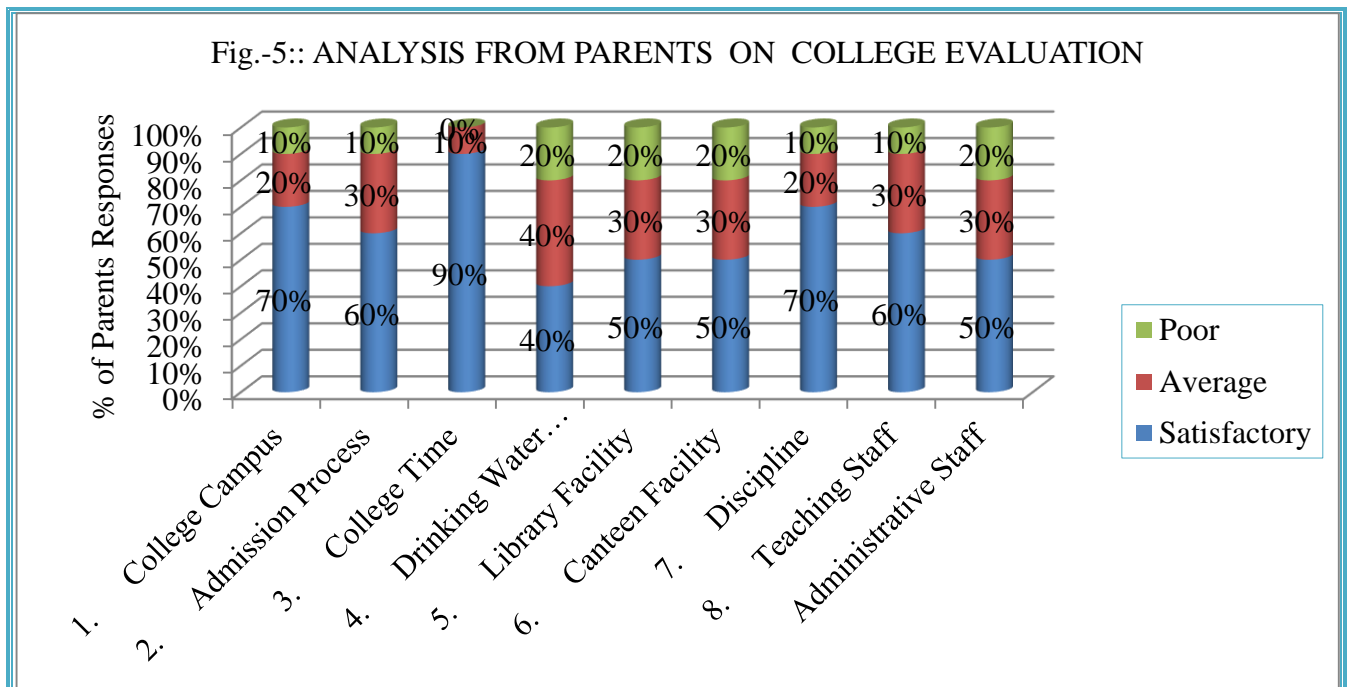
Figure 4.1 illustrates that about 70% and 30% students have scored physical facilities as good and excellent respectively.

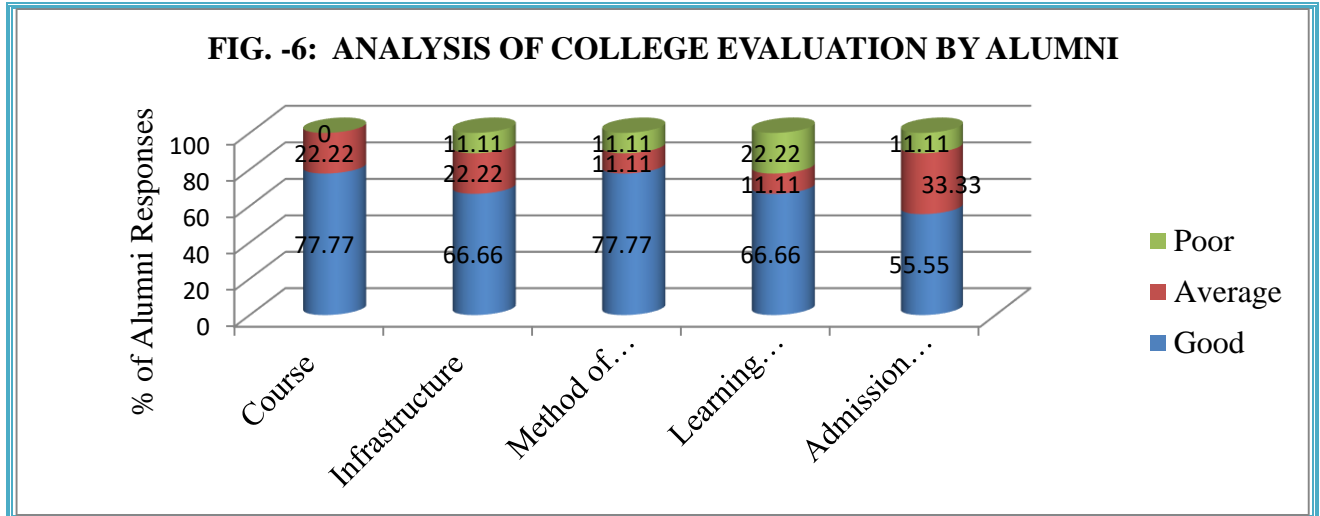

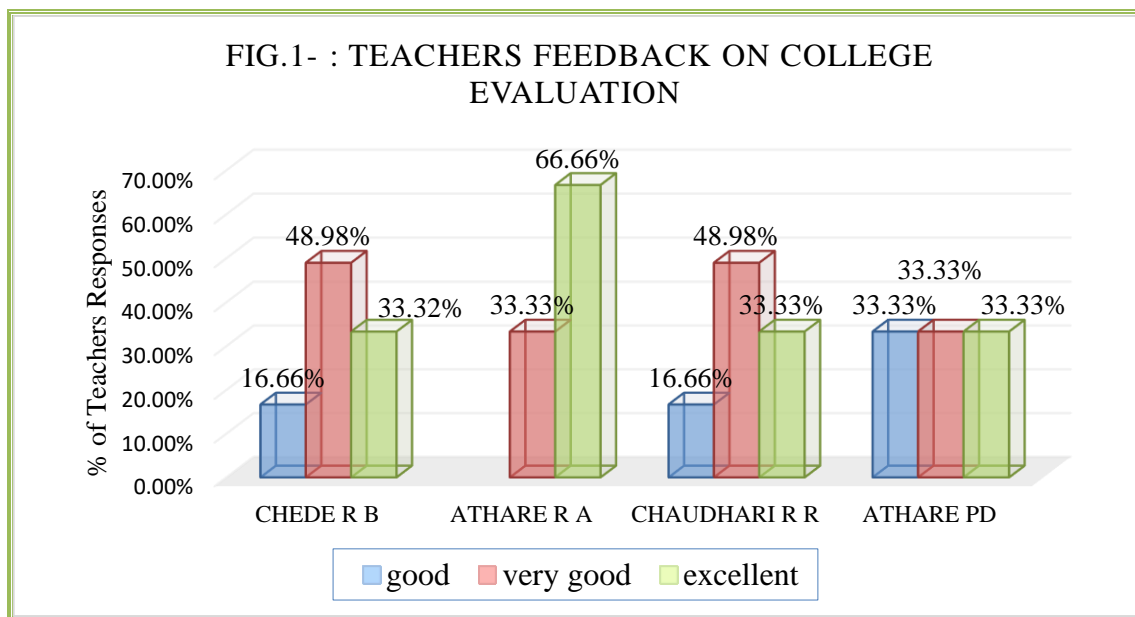

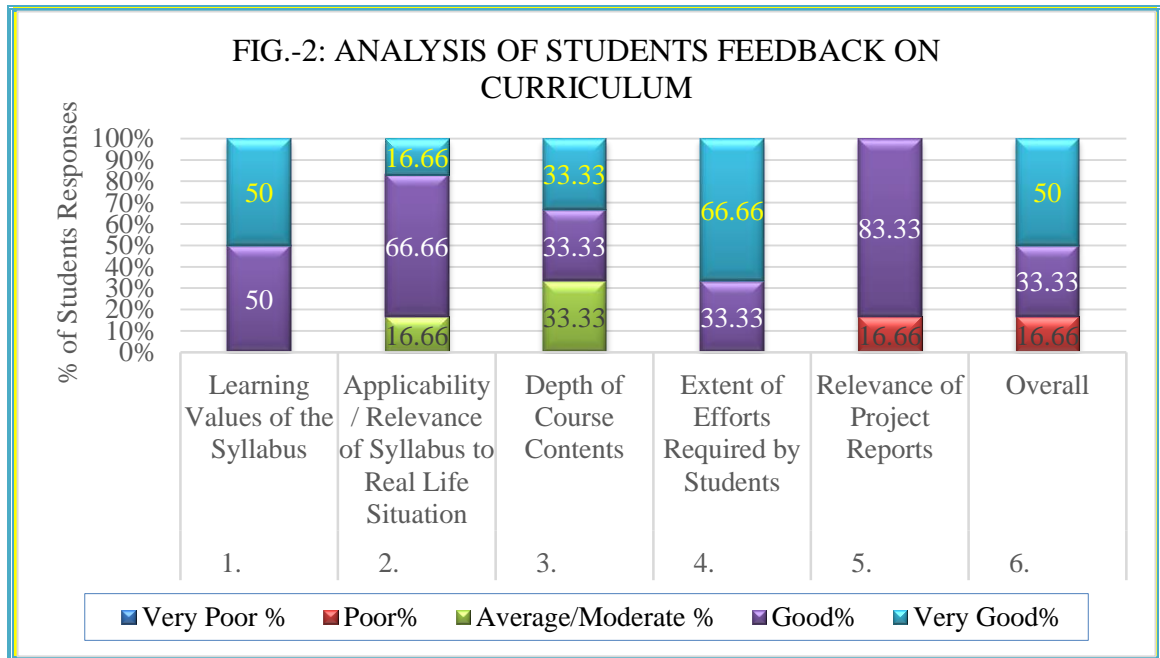

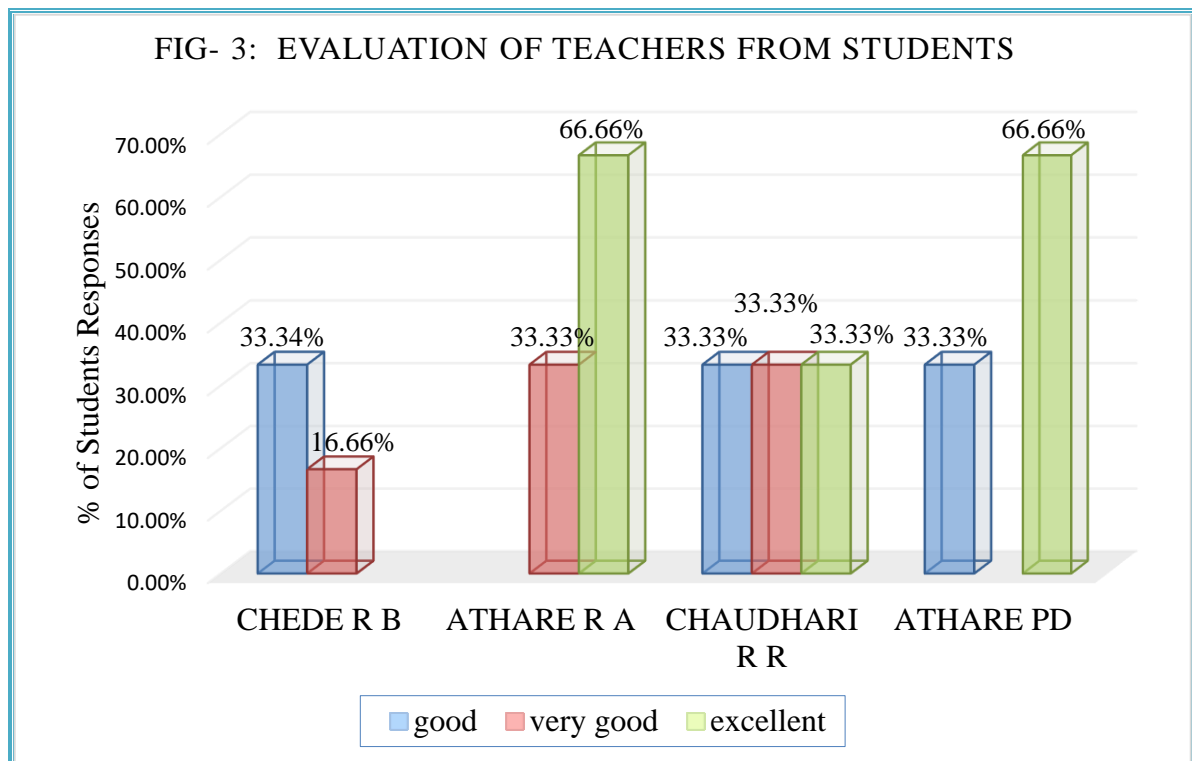

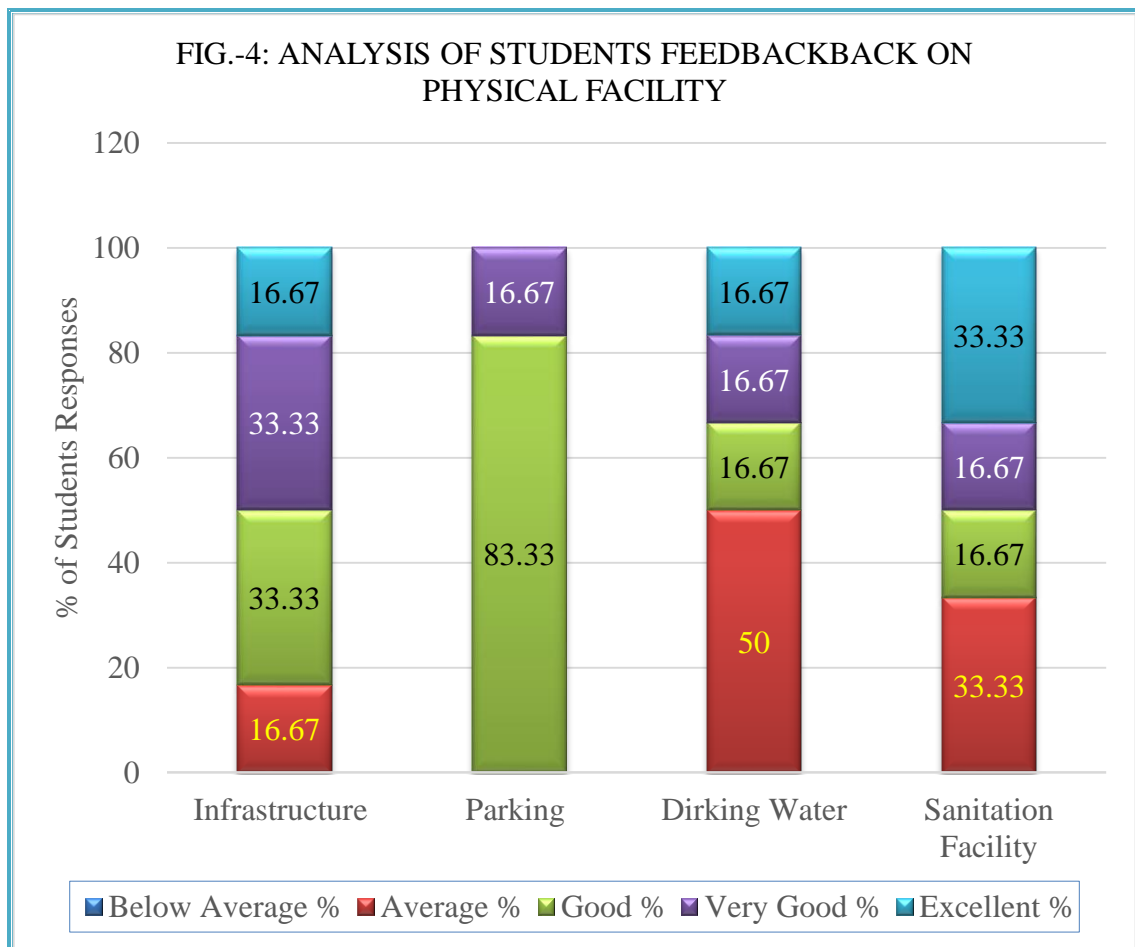

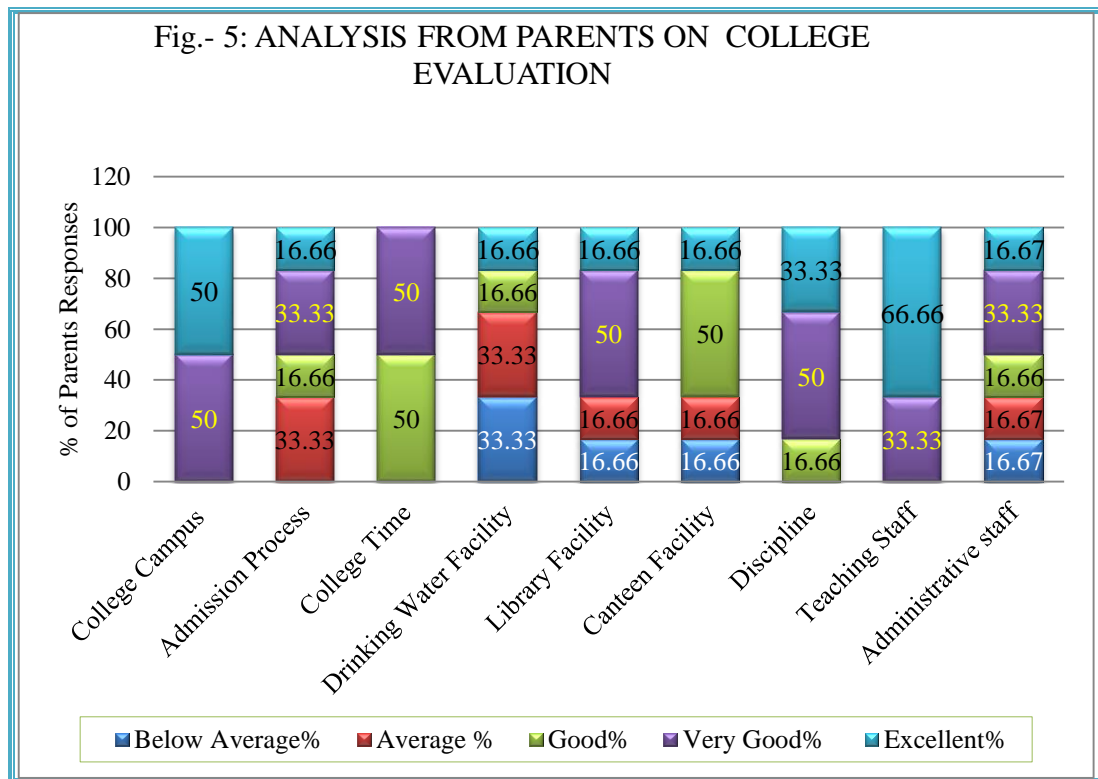

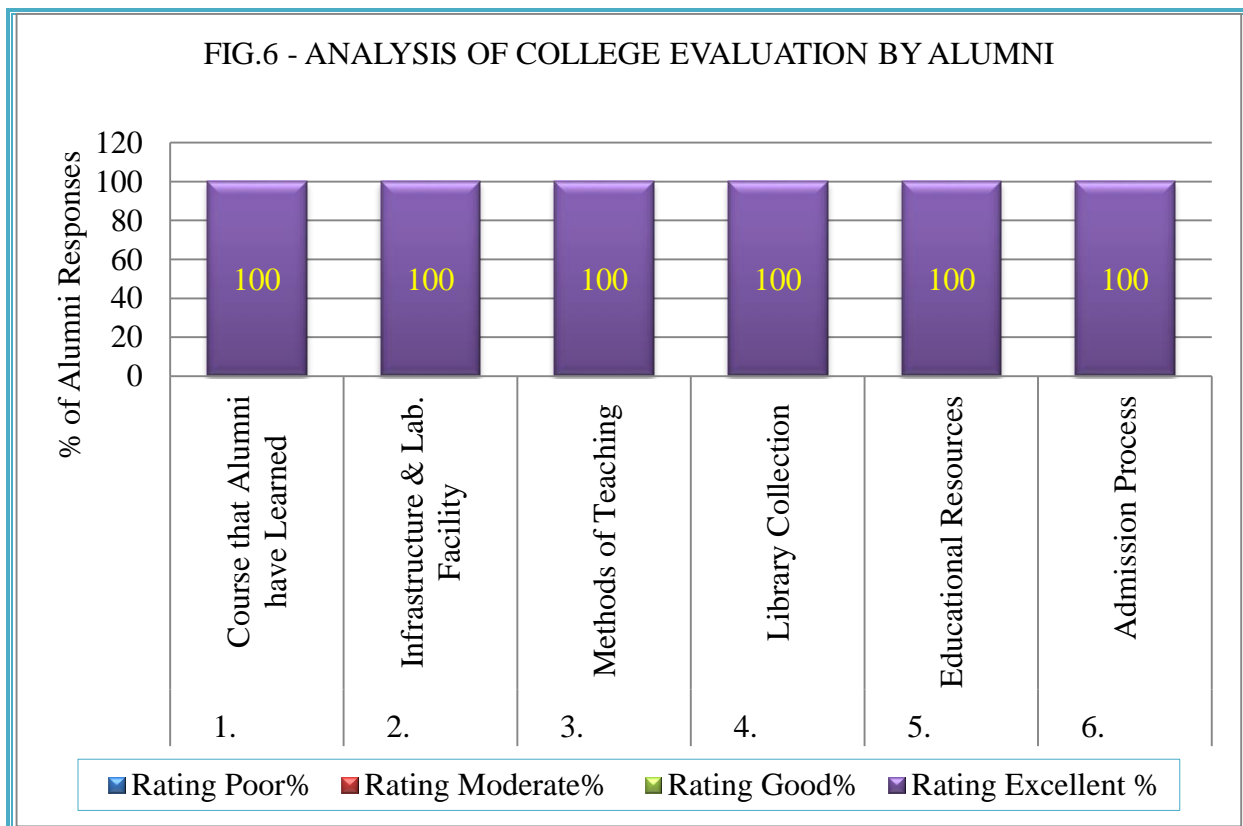

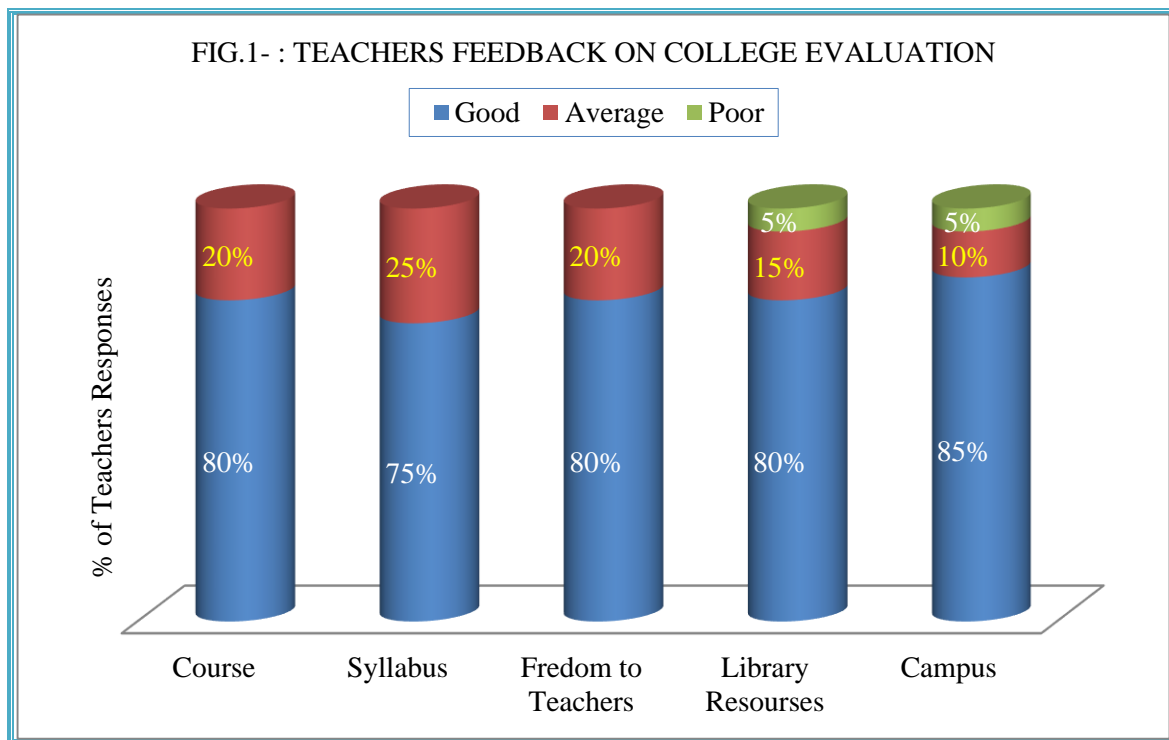
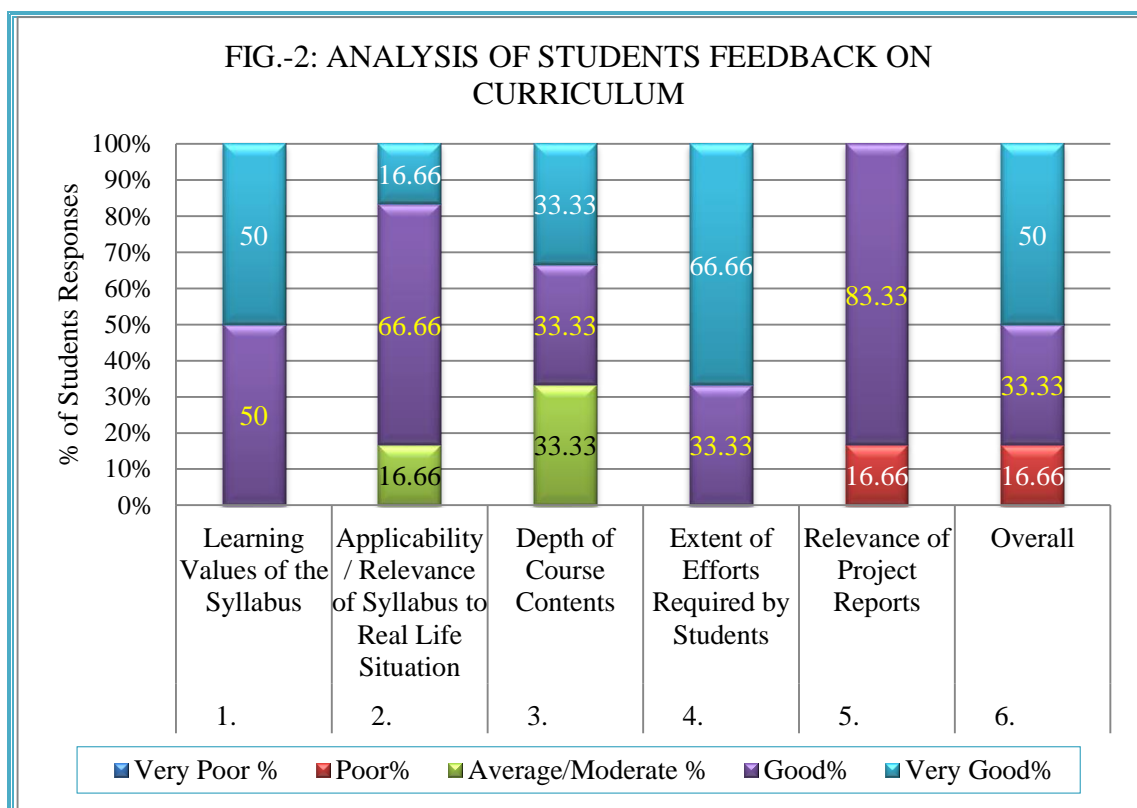

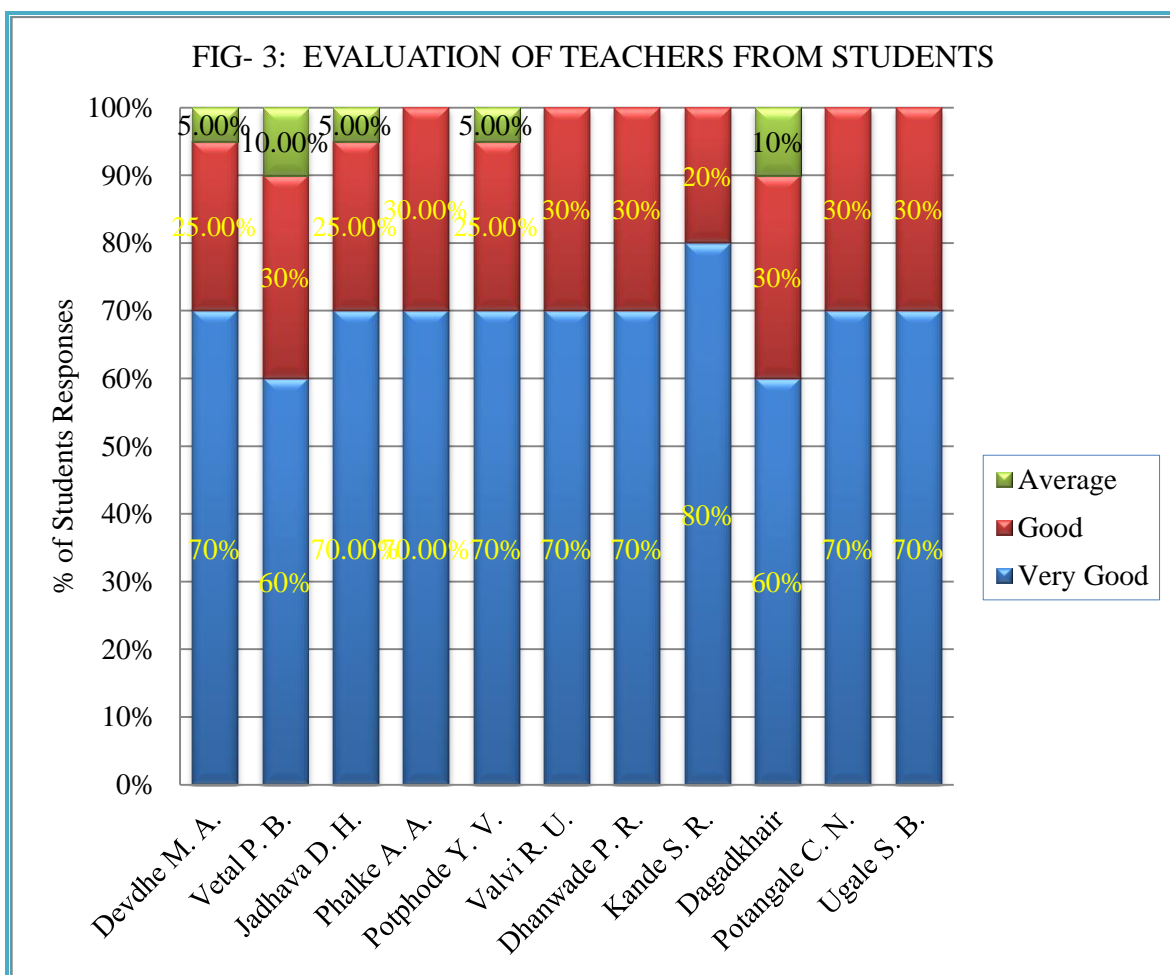

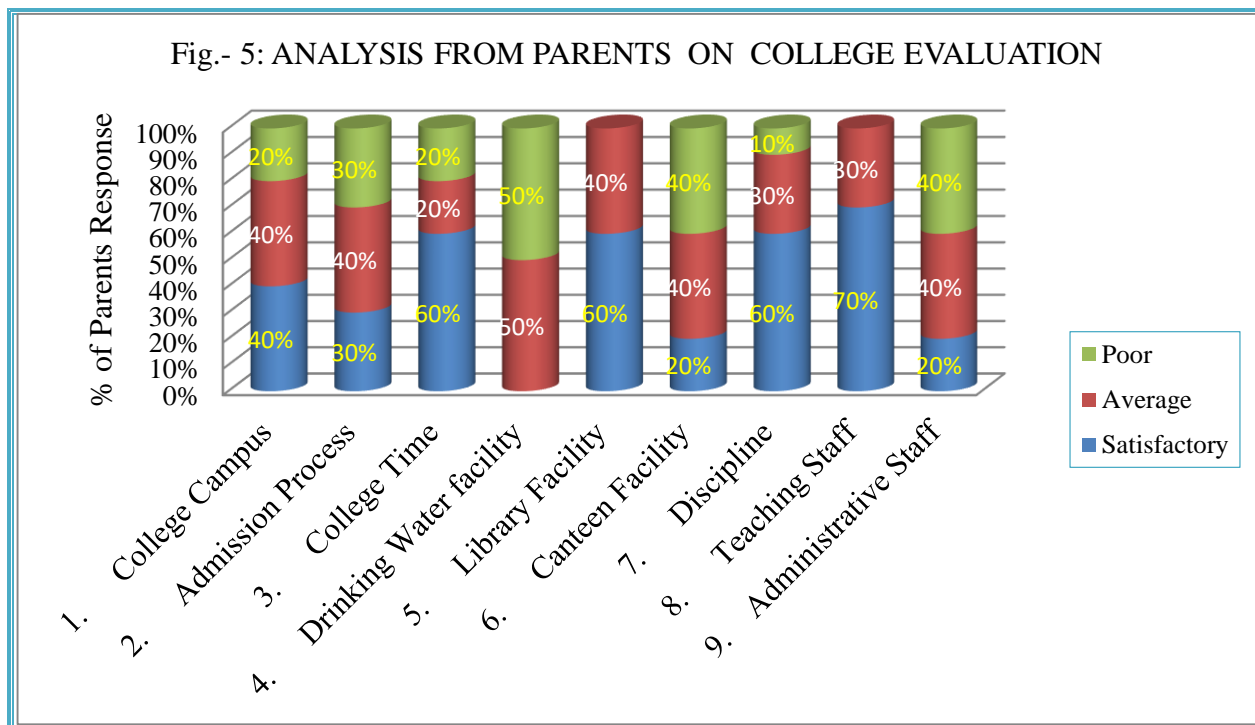

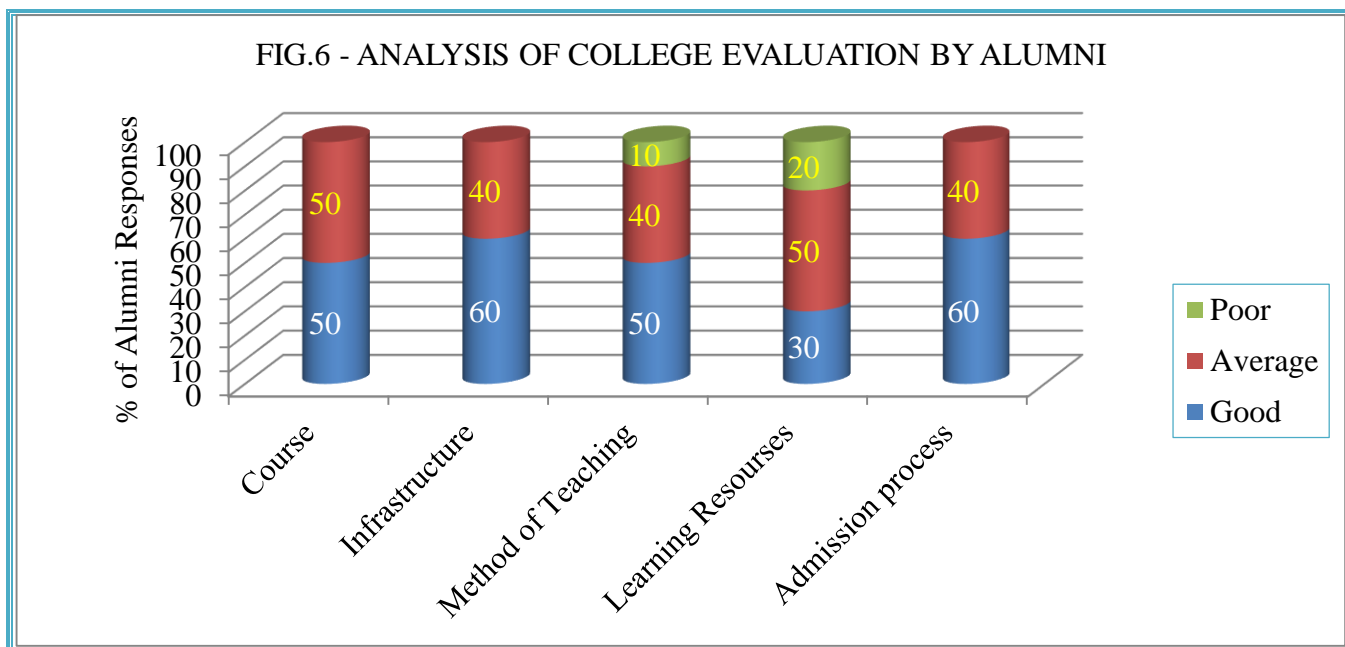

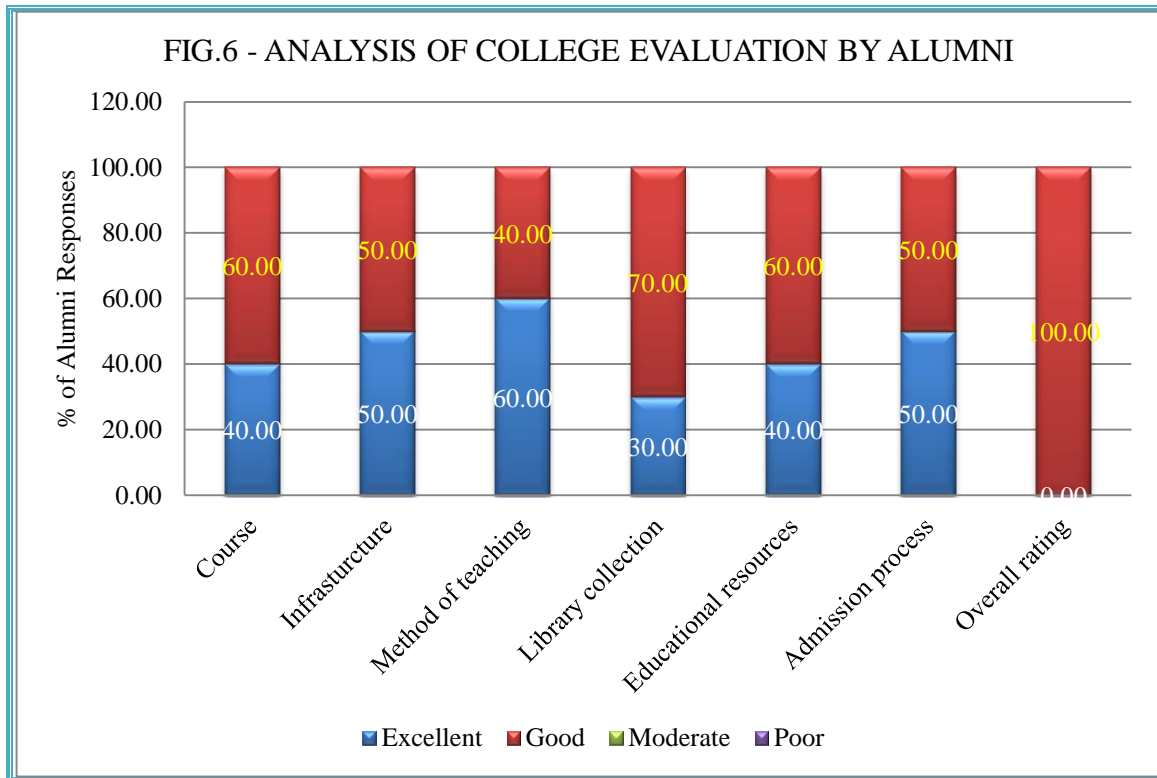
