1. BRIEF WRITE UP ON FEEDBACK PROCESS OF THE INSTITUTION

Feedback System :

1) ANALYSIS OF TEACHERS FEEDBACK ON COLLEGE EVALUATION


Five teachers of Geography department have given in their feedback on following six parameters.

When we considered aspect wise feedback analysis it is prove from fig.-1 that, about 67 percent teachers strongly accepted that teachers' friendly administration is available in the college. Besides this, cent percent teachers said that, campus and classrooms are cleaned and well maintained. Balance between theory and applications should be maintain in syllabus.

The analysis of feedback is summarized in the figure-1. About 67 to 100 percentage of teachers are satisfied with the aspects of teaching considered for feedback and its analysis. Teaching faculty expressed their strongly satisfaction or agreement ranges between 17 to 67%.

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


Table-1 and fig. -2 clearly shows that evaluation of Geography teachers from students in 2017-18. For this analysis, twenty-one students from Geography department were selected at random. Nine feedbacks received from students for evaluation of Mr. P. Y. Thombare, eight feedback for evaluation for Mr. K. D. Kambale. It was 2 feedback forms for Smt. Shital V. Hiwale, one feedback received from student each for Mr. G. S. Jadhav and Mr. H. S. Shaikh.

It is proven and summarised from Table-1 and fig.- 2 that, excellent score was assigned by 50 to 100 percent of students to teachers of Geography department. 









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













Fig. -2 illustrates that nearabout 67 % students have scored their three teachers namely Mr.

Mr. R. B. Chede in terms of above given six aspects.




























